PRESENTATION

This seminar aims to provide a floor for the presentation and discussion of current research – both French and foreign – on the theme of self-management, understood in the broadest sense. Since at least the second half of the 19th century, the idea of democratising the sphere of work, the enterprise and the economy more generally has given rise to countless theoretical discussions, academic works, trade union struggles, political proposals and concrete experiences in Europe and elsewhere. One of the most discussed ‘models’ in Europe since the Second World War is that of workers’ self-management, which was experimented in Yugoslavia from the 1950s, and was particularly prevalent in France in the 1960s and 1970s. In recent years, the theme of self-management has aroused renewed interest among historians and social scientists: the seminar aims to contribute to the dissemination of existing work but also to open up new perspectives by

encouraging a transnational, or even global approach to the question. This seminar is part of the French-German [ANR-DFG Euro-Dem project](#).
